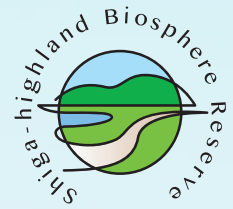




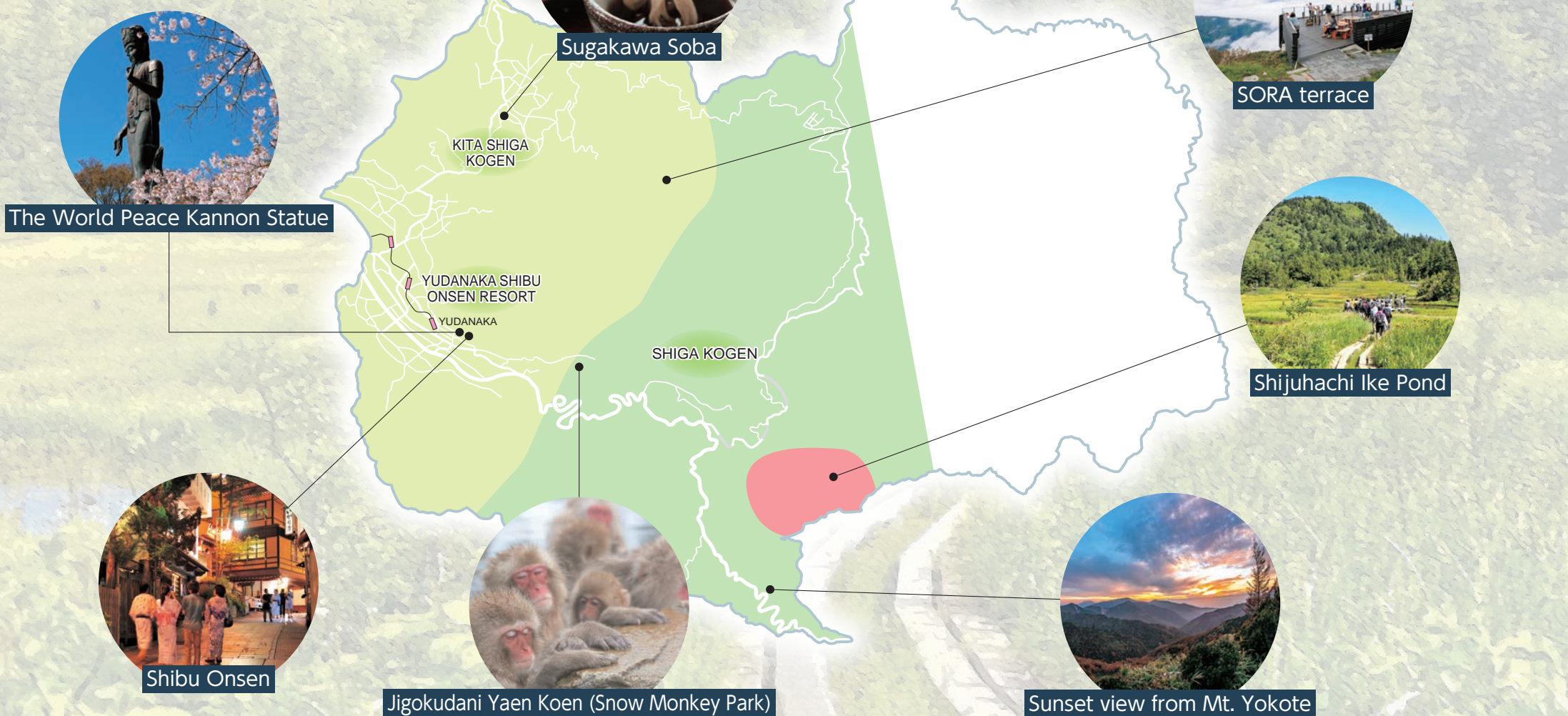
Savor Seasonal Fruits! Fruit Picking in Yamanouchi

SAVOR JAPAN is a certification system for the areas that attract foreign tourists with local foods and cultures by the Japanese Minister of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries. Yamanouchi Town has accredited as the SAVOR JAPAN area in 2019.

Local foods: Apple, Grape, Peach, Soba(buckwheat noodle), Shinshu beef(Wagyu)

Yamanouchi offers many activities such as world famous Snow Monkey Park and Shiga Kogen ski area. Local produces are grown in great natural environment, Wagyu beef is apple fed, and Soba (buckwheat noodle) contains burdock roots' fiber as a binder agent. Experience unique local foods while you can try some workshops such as bamboo craft.

What is SAVOR JAPAN?

The different regions of Japan each have their own local cuisine. SAVOR JAPAN is your guide to the attractions of Japan's small farming, fishing, and mountain communities — especially the great food they offer.

All SAVOR JAPAN areas are, after careful vetting, certified by the Japanese Minister of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries. As of 2019 there were 27 such certified areas.

SAVOR JAPAN certification is designed to draw attention to the local brand that come from the numerous farming, mountain and fishing villages throughout Japan where food is a way of life, and lead to an increase in interpersonal exchanges through a deeper discovery of Japanese cuisine and the enjoyment of unforgettable experiences in authentic Japanese food culture. 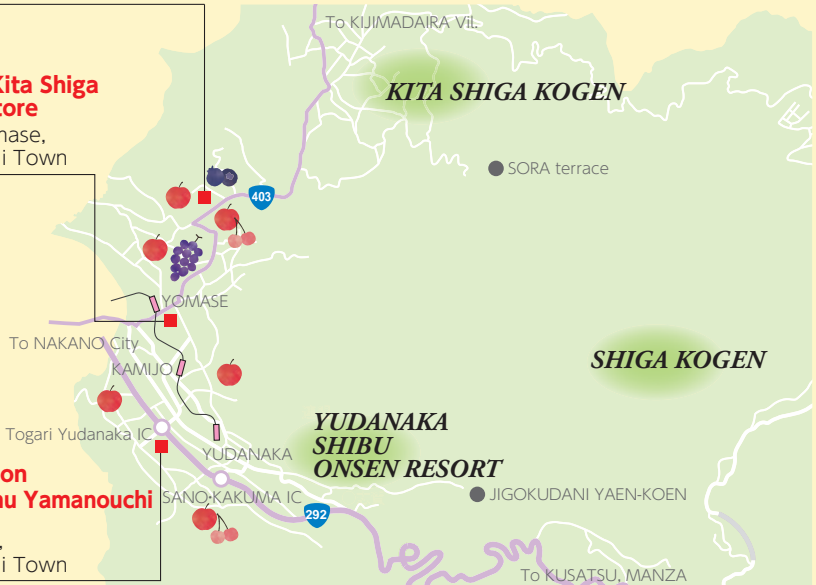

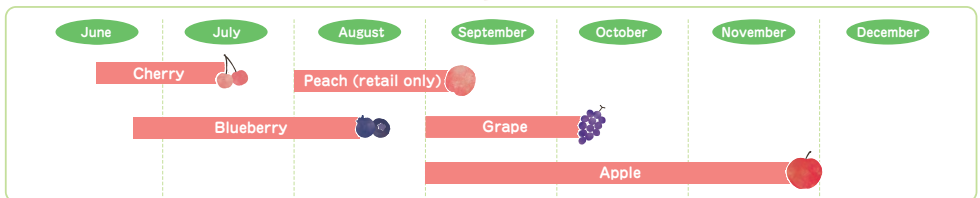
